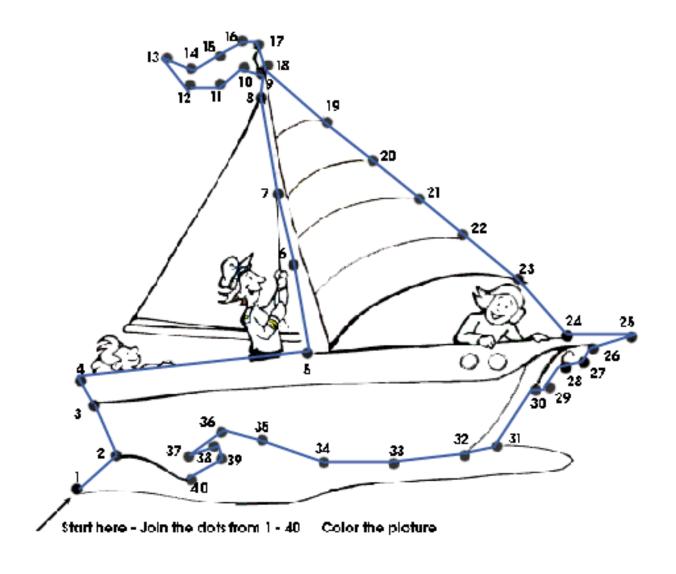

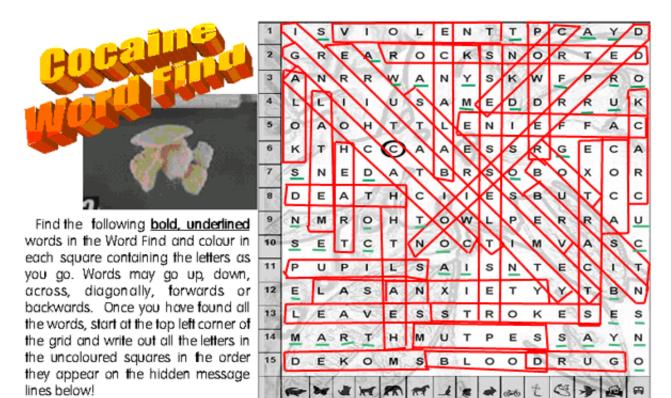

# **ANSWER SHEET – 2009 KIT 1**



Cocaine (sometimes called "Coke") is a <u>drug</u> that directly affects the <u>brain</u>. It comes from the <u>leaves</u> of the <u>coca</u> leaves grown in South America. <u>Cartata</u> got its name from this drug as it was originally made from the <u>extracts</u> of coca leaves (cocaine) and <u>kola</u> nuts (<u>caffeine</u>). Now the cocaine is removed from the drink although the leaves are still used as flavouring.



As a <u>powder</u>, cocaine is <u>snorted</u> up the nose or dissolved in water and injected. <u>Crack</u> cocaine comes in a <u>rock</u> crystal that can be heated and its vapours <u>smoked</u>. The term "crack" refers to the crackling sound heard when it is heated.

It also causes many dangerous things to happen in the body while giving the user a feeling of intense pleasure or excitement. It makes the person want to use it again and again. However, it makes the blood vessels tighten, makes the <u>pupils</u> in the eye larger, increases the body <u>temperature</u>, heart rate, and <u>blood</u> pressure. This can cause the blood <u>vessels</u> to <u>burst</u> or cause <u>heart</u> attacks and <u>strokes</u>. Snorting cocaine can <u>rot</u> the nasal septum. Using cocaine may also lead to strange, jerky and violent behaviour.

Users may experience tremors, lose their <u>balance</u>, have <u>twitching</u> muscles and feelings of <u>restlessness</u>, <u>irritability</u>, and <u>anxiety</u>. It can lead to <u>depression</u> and loss of <u>mental health</u>.
Sudden <u>death</u> can occur even with a first time use.

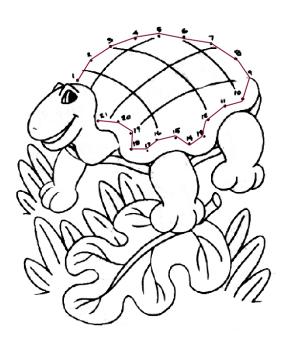
