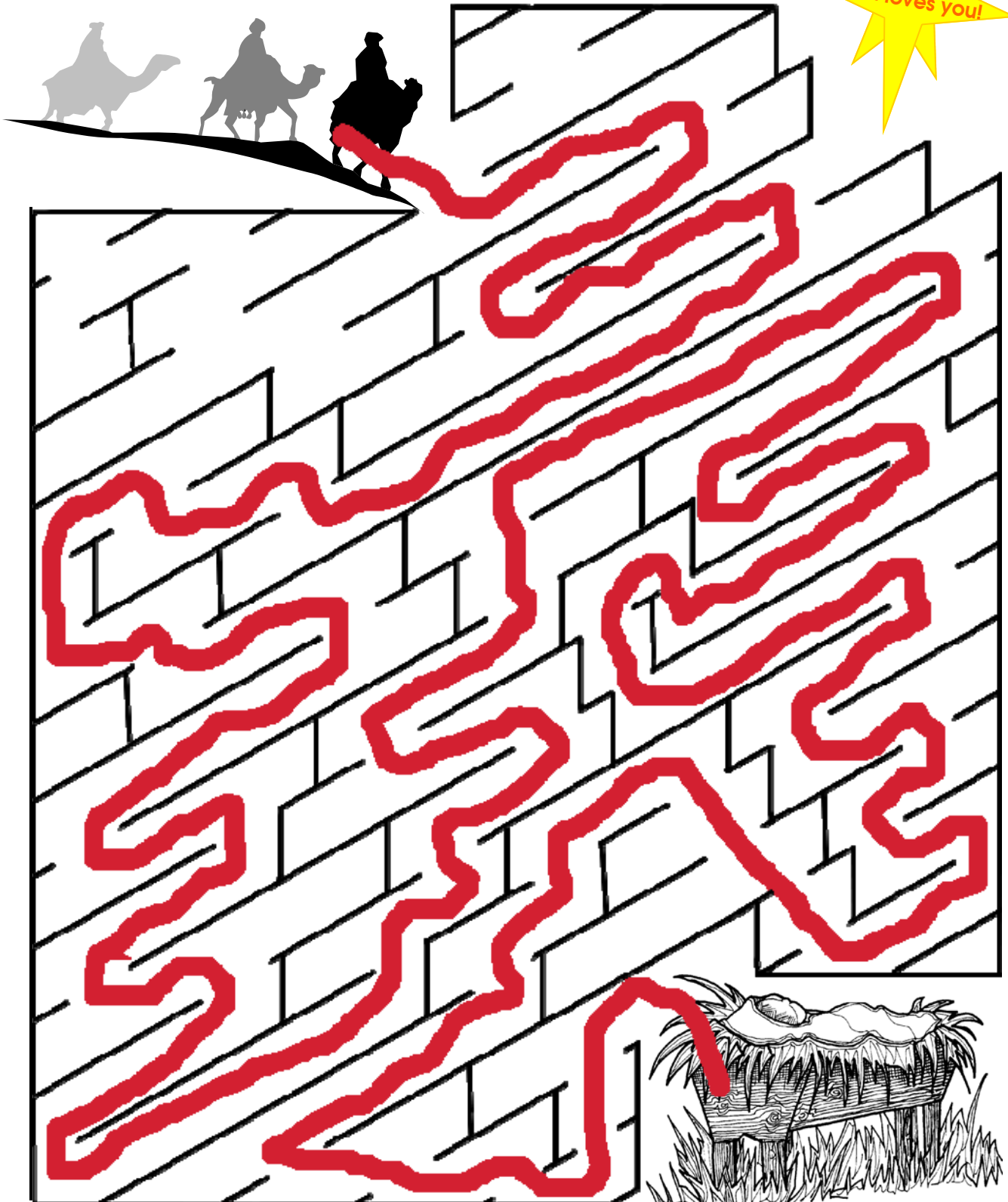


1. God's Promise to Us

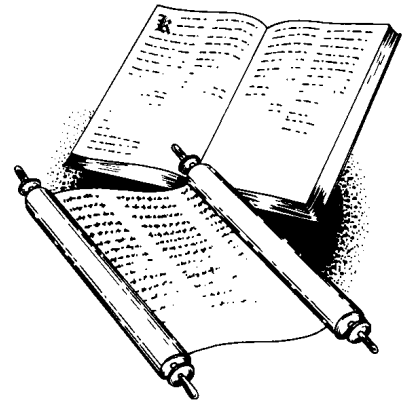

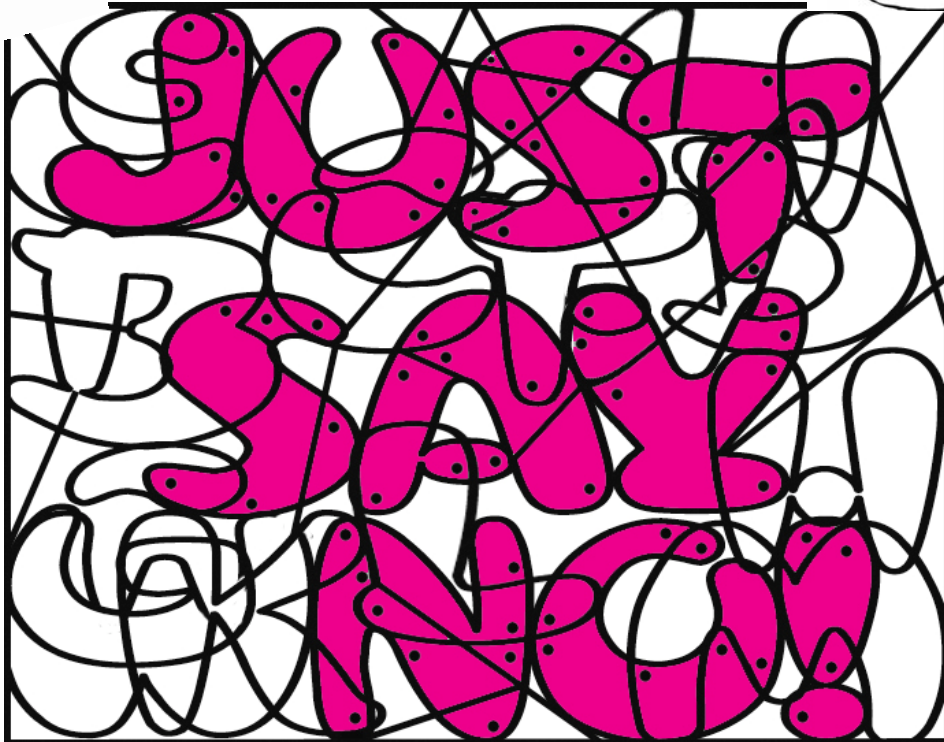
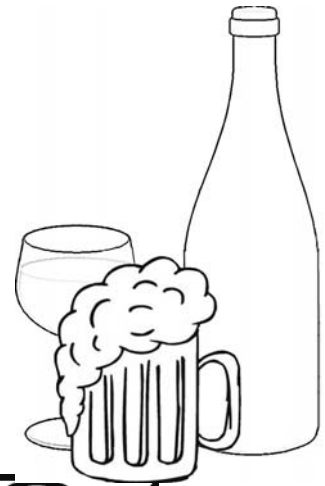

5. Resisting Temptation



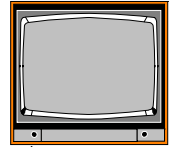
Colour each space that has a dot in it to find the key when tempted to take drugs, drink alcohol, smoke or gamble.

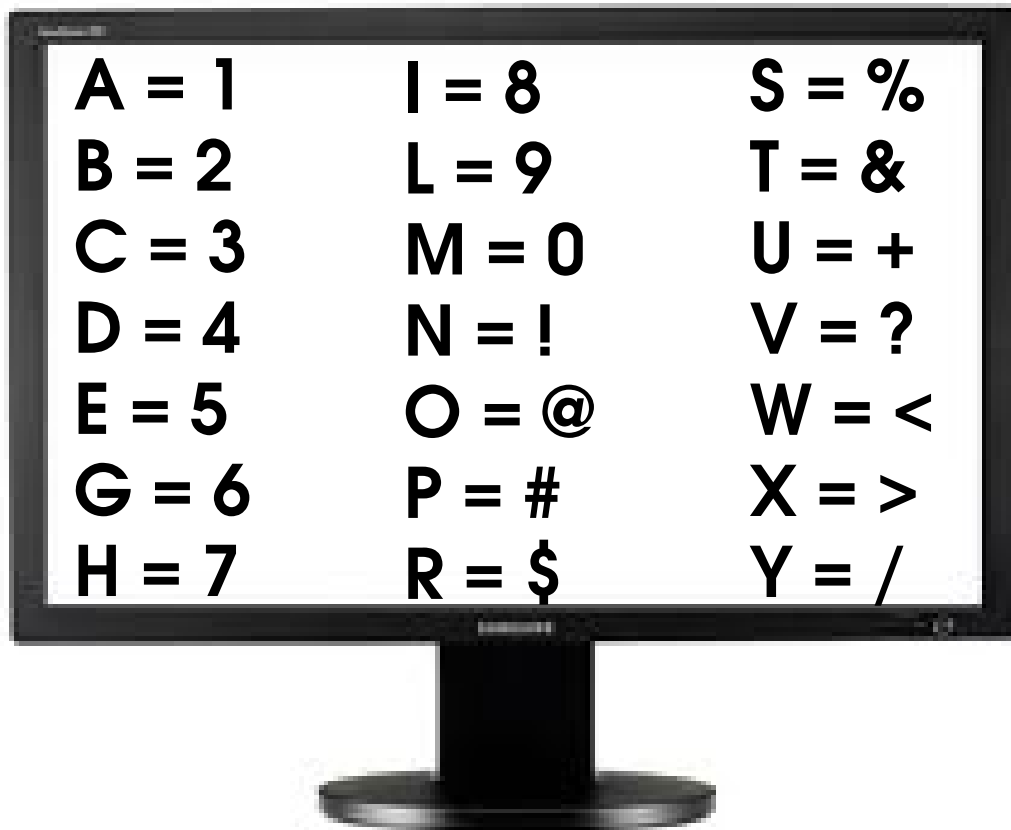
6. Safeguarding our Environment

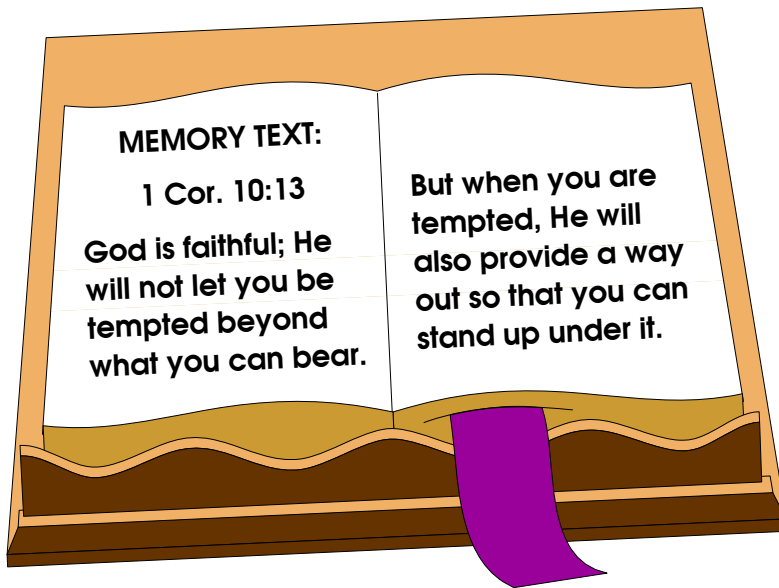

8. God's Protection and Escape Paths.

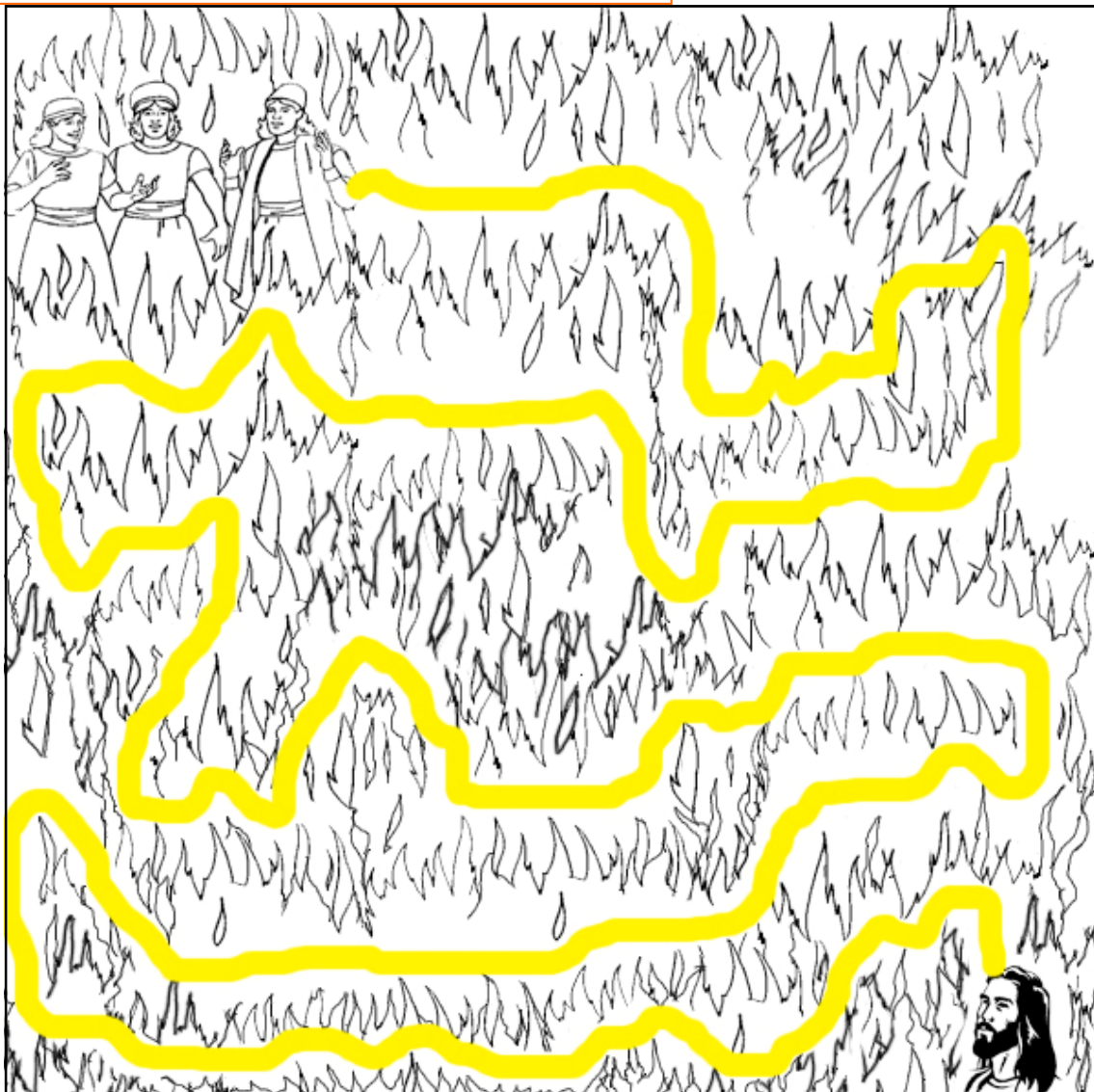


When you read Bible stories, look for God's escape plan in the stories:

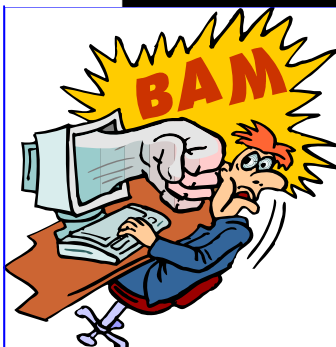

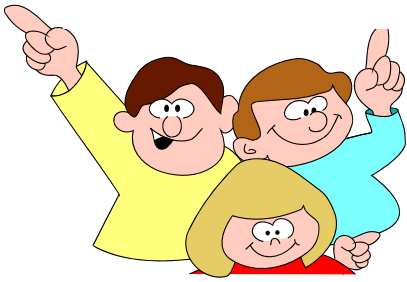
