## 2017 World Activity Kit - Children LOVE - THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

The theme for this year's activities is "Love - The Fruit of the Spirit."

Jesus said in John 15:5 (NLT)

"I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in Me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from Me you can do nothing.

Paul writes in Galatians 5:22-23 (NLT)

"..When the Holy Spirit controls our lives, He will produce this kind of fruit in us: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Here there is no conflict with the law."

John says in *1 John 4:12-16 (NIV)* 

No-one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and His love is made complete in us. We know that we live in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit. And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent His Son to be the Saviour of the world. If anyone acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God lives in him and he in God. And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him.

We want to teach our children that the only way we can be successful Christians is to be in Christ and for Christ to be in us by the power of His Holy Spirit. Any attempts that we make to produce fruit - the characteristics of a Christian life without the power of God will just be like artificial fruit - it has no ability to give life and no flavour to bring satisfaction, but is just external.

The verse in Galatians speaks of the "fruit" (singular) of the Spirit. The characteristics that are mentioned are not different fruits, but the one fruit - the loveliness of Jesus' life displayed through our lives.

Bible scholars have suggested that the fruit is actually "LOVE" - the very character of God - displayed in different forms:<sup>1</sup>

1. Rejoicing love - Joy

5. Correcting love - Goodness

2. Reconciling love - Peace

6. Reliable love - Faithfulness

3. Enduring love - Patience

7. Humble love - Gentleness

4. Amiable love - Kindness

8. Disciplined love - Self-control

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There are a number of activities related to the following memory verses that can be used during this year as well.

Fruit:

John 15:5 (NLT) "I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in Me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from Me you can do nothing. (Activity 1)

Galatians 5:22-23 (NLT) "...When the Holy Spirit controls our lives, He will produce this kind of fruit in us: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Here there is no conflict with the law." (Activity 2)

Love: (Activity 3)

1 John 4:12-16 (NIV) No-one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and His love is made complete in us. We know that we live in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit. And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent His Son to be the Saviour of the world. If anyone acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God lives in him and he in God. And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him.

John 3:16 (NIV) "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Joy: (Activity 4)

Romans 15:13 (NIV) May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Peace: (Activity 5)

John 14:27 (NIV) Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

Romans 12:18 (NIV) If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.

Patience: (Activity 6)

Colossians 1:11 (NLT) We also pray that you will be strengthened with His glorious power so that you will have all the patience and endurance you need.

Kindness: (Activity 7)

Jeremiah 31:3 (NIV) The LORD appeared to us in the past, saying: "I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with loving-kindness.

Goodness: (Activity 8)

Ephesians 5:8b-10 (NIV) Live as children of light (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) and find out what pleases the Lord.

Faithfulness: (Activity 9)

3 John 1:3 (NIV) It gave me great joy to have some brothers come and tell about your faithfulness to the truth and how you continue to walk in the truth.

Gentleness: (Activity 10)

Philippians 4:5 (NIV) Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.

Self-control: (Activity 11)

Proverbs 25:28 (NLT) A person without self-control is as defenseless as a city with broken-down walls.
